Value Added Services(3)(4)

You can customise your FedEx services to your needs (or the needs of your recipients) with value added services from FedEx Express. The following are descriptions of the fees applicable to value added services.

Dangerous Goods Only available on Express Services.	FedEx Express Dangerous Goods services allow the shipping of regulated dangerous substances and materials including door-to-door delivery and customs clearance. Applicable fee depends on the Dangerous Goods type: • Accessible Dangerous Goods (ADG) The content of package must be accessible during transit for security reasons. • Inaccessible Dangerous Goods (IDG) The content of package does not have to be accessed during transit and can be mixed with other freight. • Dry Ice (DI) Dry ice is a hazardous commodity that requires special handling, subject to simplified regulations. This means it can be offered in locations where fully regulated Dangerous Goods services are not offered. • Lithium Batteries Section II (ELB) Four commodities are covered: 1. Lithium lon packed with equipment (UN 3481 - Packing Instruction 966). 2. Lithium lon contained in equipment (UN 3481 - Packing Instruction 967). 3. Lithium Metal packed with equipment (UN 3091 - Packing Instruction 969). 4. Lithium Metal contained in equipment (UN 3091 - Packing Instruction 970). In case a shipment contains Dry Ice or Lithium Battery Section II with another Dangerous Good, only the respective (Accessible or Inaccessible) Dangerous Goods surcharge applies. Note: For Dangerous Goods, only Lithium Batteries Section II (ELB) applies to FedEx International Connect Plus service. FedEx® Electronic Trade Documents	With FedEx Electronic Trade Documents (ETD) you can streamline your international shipments by uploading your customs documentation electronically. ETD reduces the amount of paper you print for each shipment, allows for faster pickup and helps to pre-clear your shipments, reducing the risk of your shipment being delayed in customs.	None
FedEx® Global Returns or FedEx Import Shipping Print Label	Create return or import shipping labels on your computer or shipping system. Then simply print and provide the label to your customer or send it as PDF via email.	None

With FPA+, re-icing, gel pack replenishments & cold storage are included as standard in the service. FPA+ is available for FedEx international express services. On Demand Care (7)	On Demand Care (ODC) is a fee-based service for non-food items providing intervention services such as Dry Ice replenishment and gel pack reconditioning/exchange, to protect the integrity of temperature-controlled shipments delayed in-transit. This service is not available at all locations. This service is not guaranteed and is subject to the identification of the shipment and must be booked via Customer Service. Your transportation costs may be affected by additional charges. The following are descriptions of the surcharges.

Additional Handling Surcharge	Package Services A surcharge applies to a shipment containing any package that: Dimension • measures greater than 121 centimetres along its longest side; • measures greater than 76 centimetres along its second-longest side; or,	€45/shipment

Freight Services A surcharge applies to a shipment containing any freight handling unit that measures greater than 157 centimetres along its longest side. Additional Handling Surcharge – Non-stackable ⁽⁸⁾	A surcharge applies to any FedEx International Priority Freight, FedEx International Economy Freight and FedEx Regional Economy Freight shipment containing at least one piece, skid or pallet that is non-stackable. Non-stackable means that a piece, skid or pallet cannot be stacked vertically in a safe and secure manner. Examples include, but are not limited to, non-stackable freight handling units that: 1) do not have a flat and stable top or base, 2) may be damaged if another piece is loaded on them, or 3) have flat and stable loading surfaces but are too narrow to safely and securely support other freight handling units (e.g. 1-2 barrels or drums). This surcharge applies once per shipment, even if multiple pieces identified as non-stackable are bundled in a shipment.	€154/shipment
Address Correction	If a recipient's address on an Air Bill, Air Waybill or shipping label is incomplete or incorrect, we may attempt to find the correct address and complete delivery and we will assess a surcharge. If we are unable to complete delivery, we are not liable for failing to meet our delivery commitment. For FedEx International Broker Select, the address correction surcharge will apply if the broker's address is incomplete or incorrect on the Air Waybill or other shipping documentation. If we cannot determine the correct address or cannot reach the broker, we may attempt to contact the sender for address clarification or instructions to return the shipment. Declared Value (Declared Value for Carriage for international express parcel and freight services)	FedEx Express does not provide cargo liability or all-risk insurance for shipments. The sender may however, elect to pay an additional charge to specify a declared value for carriage on the air waybill, above the standard limits of liability. The Declared Value for Carriage is limited to a maximum amount and may vary by location. The Declared Value for Carriage may not exceed: • FedEx® Envelope or Pak: US\$100 per shipment (or equivalent value in local currency); • Other services except freight transportation services: US\$50,000 per shipment (or equivalent value in local currency); • IPF, IEF and REF: US\$100,000 per shipment to most destinations (or equivalent value in local currency); • For certain Unique Items: US\$1,000 per shipment (see our Terms and Conditions of Carriage for full details); • Actual value of the contents of the shipment; • Declared Value for Customs: The selling price or replacement cost of the shipment contents as required for Customs clearance purposes.	Declared value rates are incremental and depend on the amount the customer declares. The first US\$100 of value in shipment is included in shipping rate at no extra charge as part of our standard US\$100 limit of liability. The declared value fees reflect any amount that exceeds that US\$100. A fee of €0.92 per US\$100 or €22 per kilogram, whichever is greater, will be assessed for each additional US\$100 (or part thereof) of liability that FedEx Express accepts above the standard limits of liability.
Extended Area Service	Shipments picked up from or delivered to remote and less accessible locations are assessed an Out-of-Pick-up-Area (OPA) or Out-of-Delivery-Area (ODA) surcharge. FedEx reserves the right to apply a fuel surcharge. Regional Fuel Surcharge For FedEx Regional Economy and FedEx Regional Economy Freight services, FedEx Express has adopted a Dynamic Fuel Surcharge which is based on the automotive gas oil prices from the EU country/territory zone. Oversize Charge	An oversize charge applies to a shipment containing packages that exceed 243 centimetres in length or 330 centimetres in length and girth (L+2W+2H). Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time.	€55/shipment
Peak Surcharge	During specific times of the year, the Peak Surcharge will apply to packages meeting the criteria and characteristics as determined by FedEx.
