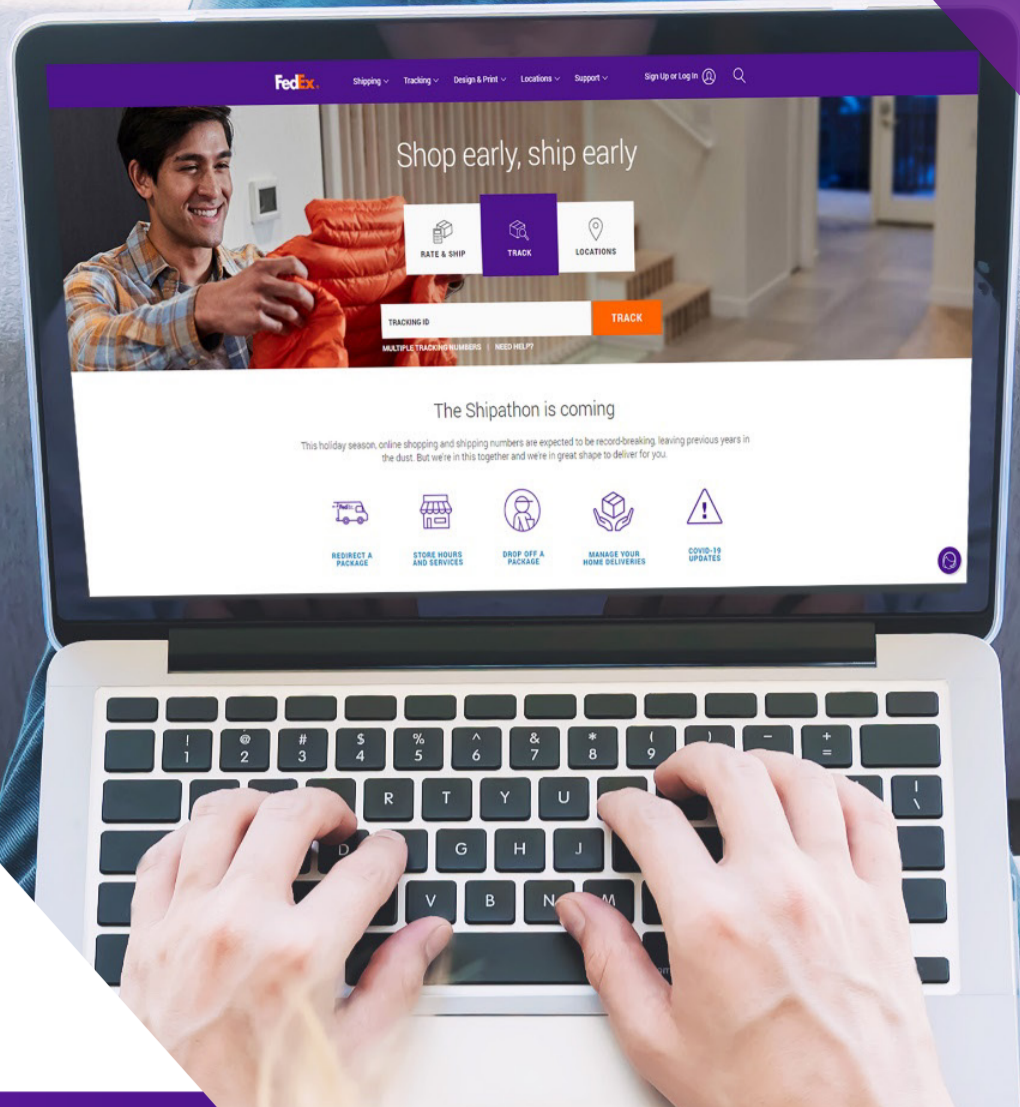




How to ship with ETD when creating shipment through FedEx Web Services

Option 1: Use FedEx Generated Invoice

1 Use Upload Image Request to upload Commercial Invoice Letterhead and Signature

How to ship with ETD when creating shipment through **FedEx Web Services**



Option 1: Use FedEx Generated Invoice

2 Specify `imageStatuses/Id` returned from Upload Image Request to the Ship Request

Option 2: Use Your Own Invoice – Pre-Shipment

1 Use Upload Document Request to upload your own invoice

Option 2: Use Your Own Invoice – Pre-Shipment

2 Add **SpecialServicesRequested** and specify **DocumentId** returned from **Upload Document Request** to the **Ship Request**

Option 3: Use Your Own Invoice – Post-Shipment

1 Add **SpecialServiceRequested** and specify **Post Shipment Upload** option to the **Ship Request**

2 Use Upload Document Request to upload your own invoice after the shipment is created

How to ship with ETD when creating shipment through **FedEx Web Services**

Points to Note

If your shipment destination requires a hard copy of Commercial Invoice, “**EWO**” will be printed on the AWB and “**ELECTRONIC_DOCUMENTS_WITH_ORIGINALS**” will be returned from the Ship request. Please print the number of copies according to the value of “**MinimumCopiesRequired**” in the Ship response.
