When a wing flap was damaged on the ground, a company quickly engaged FedEx Customized Freight to replace the needed, oversize component. Long and thin, the delicate wing flap required special handling equipment in order to not bend or damage the wing surface. Side-load trucks were used on the ground to transport the part to the outbound gateway. The FedEx Customized Freight team engaged a special build-up crew to make sure the part was set for air travel from Europe. Once safely on the ground in Singapore, the team retrieved the flap and expedited it to the maintenance crew at the designated time.

A China supplier went through some challenging times with inventory and quickly became delayed in its new seat production, resulting in an aircraft manufacturer being down while waiting on seats being shipped on a slower mode of transportation. Because the downtime proved cost-prohibitive for the manufacturer, the supplier turned to FedEx Customized Freight for an expedited solution.
