Customers registered for the ImportOne service will receive discounts based on the published destination-based International Import Express base rates, as indicated in their pricing agreement. For all other customers who have not registered for ImportOne service, surcharges applied on inbound/third-party shipments will be determined by the originating country/territory.

1. Australia and New Zealand: Includes Australia, New Zealand, Brunei, Cambodia, Guam and Laos.
2. Asia: Includes Japan, Singapore, South Korea, Hong Kong SAR China, Malaysia, Taiwan China, Thailand, Vietnam, Philippines, Indonesia, Macau SAR China and Mongolia.
3. USA, Canada, Mexico and Puerto Rico: Includes United States of America, Canada, Mexico and Puerto Rico.
4. EU: Includes Andorra, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Faeroe Islands, Greenland, Hungary, Iceland, Israel, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Turkey, Ukraine, Belgium, Canary Islands, Channel Islands, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, San Marino, Spain, United Kingdom, Vatican City, Austria, Denmark, Finland, Greece, Ireland, Luxembourg, Monaco, Norway, Portugal, Russia, Sweden and Switzerland.
