Value Added Services(1)(2)

You can customise your FedEx services to your needs (or the needs of your recipients) with value added services from FedEx Express. The following are descriptions of the fees applicable to value added services.

Dangerous Goods Only available on Express Services.	FedEx Express Dangerous Goods services allow the shipping of regulated dangerous substances and materials including door-to-door delivery and customs clearance. Applicable fee depends on the Dangerous Goods type: • Accessible Dangerous Goods (ADG) The content of package must be accessible during transit for security reasons. • Inaccessible Dangerous Goods (IDG) The content of package does not have to be accessed during transit and can be mixed with other freight. • Dry Ice (DI) Dry ice is a hazardous commodity that requires special handling, subject to simplified regulations. This means it can be offered in locations where fully regulated Dangerous Goods services are not offered. In case a shipment contains both Dry Ice and Dangerous Goods, only the respective Dangerous Goods surcharge applies. FedEx® Delivery Signature Options	The following delivery signature options ⁽⁴⁾ may be chosen at the time of booking your shipment: 1. No Signature Required: FedEx will attempt to obtain a signature at the delivery address. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will deliver the package in a safe place without obtaining signature. 2. Indirect Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address, from a neighbour or from a building manager. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 3. Direct Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address only. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 4. Adult Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from any person of legal age at the delivery address, subject to sighting of a valid ID. If no one eligible to sign is available, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. Legal age will vary depending on the destination country/territory and is governed by local legal age of an adult, not the legal age to purchase specific products (i.e. alcohol). Your transportation costs may be affected by additional charges. The following are descriptions of the surcharges.

Additional Handling Surcharge	Effective January 6,2025, FedEx will assess an Additional Handling Surcharge per eligible package for international multi-piece shipments, instead of per shipment. Package Services An Additional Handling Surcharge applies to any package that meets any of the following criteria: Dimension • measures greater than 121 centimeters along its longest side; • measures greater than 76 centimeters along its second-longest side; or, • measures greater than 266 centimeters in length and girth (L+2W+2H). Weight • has an actual weight greater than 31kg. Packaging • is not fully encased in an outer shipping container; • is encased in an outer shipping container not made of corrugated fibreboard (cardboard) materials, including but not limited to metal, wood, canvas, leather, hard plastic, soft plastic, or expanded polystyrene foam (e.g. Styrofoam); • is encased in an outer shipping container covered in shrink wrap or stretch wrap; • is round or cylindrical, including (without limitation) mailing tubes, cans, buckets, barrels, tires, drums, or pails; • is bound with metal, plastic, or cloth banding, or has wheels, casters, handles, or straps (e.g., a bicycle) (including packages where the outer surface area is loosely wrapped, or where the contents protrude outside the surface area); • could become entangled in, or cause damage to other packages or the FedEx sortation system. We reserve the right to assess additional handling charges for packages that require special handling or that require FedEx to apply additional packaging during transit. If a package is eligible for 2 or all 3 Additional Handling Surcharges, only 1 with greater charge will apply. Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time. Effective January 6,2025, FedEx will assess an Additional Handling Surcharge per eligible package for international multi-piece shipments, instead of per shipment. A surcharge applies to any freight handling unit that is non-stackable, which	
	means the piece, skid, or pallet cannot be stacked vertically in a safe and secure manner. Examples include, but are not limited to, non-stackable freight handling units that: do not have a flat and stable top or base; may be damaged if another piece is loaded on them; or, have flat and stable loading surfaces but are too narrow to safely and securely support other freight handling units (e.g. 1-2 barrels or drums). Address Correction	If a recipient's address on an Air Bill, Air Waybill or shipping label is incomplete or incorrect, we may attempt to find the correct address and complete delivery and we will assess a surcharge. If we are unable to complete delivery, we are not liable for failing to meet our delivery commitment. For FedEx International Broker Select, the address correction surcharge will apply if the broker's address is incomplete or incorrect on the Air Waybill or other shipping documentation. If we cannot determine the correct address or cannot reach the broker, we may attempt to contact the sender for address clarification or instructions to return the shipment. An oversize charge applies to a package that exceed 243 centimeters in length* or 330 centimeters in length* and girth (L+2W+2H). Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligibility. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time.	KES 5,445/package

Third Party Billing	Third Party Billing Surcharge will apply to shipments that are billed to a third party. The surcharge will be charged to the third-party payer ⁽⁶⁾ .
