


#### Step 1 - Login to fedex.com





#### **Step 2 – Click on "My Profile" under Account Tab**




### Step 3 – Click "Add an account" under Account Management

# Q2: I received an email to view my account based rate sheet via FedEx Rate Sheet tool but I do not have access to the tool. How do I get access?

Firstly, you must have a fedex.com login credential (user ID and password) to access the FedEx Rate Sheets. If you don't have fedex.com user ID, please go to the fedex.com home page.

Click on "Sign Up/Log In". When the question "Don't have a fedex.com User ID?" appears, you need to select "I Already have a FedEx Account". You must provide the information requested to finalize the registration.

# Q3: I have submitted access request for my FedEx account. However, I haven't received any update. How do I get access?

# Q5: How can I delegate access rights to other users and download Rate Sheets via FedEx Rate Sheet Tools?

You can leverage the FedEx Administration application to provide additional users the privilege to view and download rate sheets on fedex.com for your shipping account.

# Q6: I have received an email about being invited to access FedEx Ship Manager at fedex.com by creating a new fedex.com login. Can I use my existing fedex.com login account to proceed?

No. Since your existing fedex.com login is already setup with list of access right, you must create a new fedex.com login to connect your login to the invited account




# Q7: The rate admin of my FedEx account has left my company. How do I assign a new user the rate admin role for my FedEx account?






Q7: The rate admin of my FedEx account has left my company. How do I assign a new user the rate admin role for my FedEx account?

#### Step 3 - Click on "Account"



# Step 4 – Click on "Add New User" and enter the new users' name and email address


If the new administrator is not in the "All users" list, click "Add New User" and enter the new users' name and email address. New users will then receive an email invite to obtain access to the account specific rates.

# Q8: I have already logged into my account. Why do I need to select my local language and currency again?

English language and rate scale currency are pre-selected, local language (if applicable) or other currency is optional to select.

#### Q9: Why I cannot get the surcharge list together?

Rate sheet provides customer net rates and zone index only. You may download surcharge from fedex.com.

Surcharges, ancillary/other charges, special handling fees, duties and taxes are not included. If you want to consult the standard surcharges, you can click on "Get standard rates". You will be directed to the fedex.com Rates & Surcharges page where you can check the standard surcharges.

#### Q10: If I click other currency, what is the exchange rate?

It is based on the internal Enterprise Currency Conversion (ECC) system. (Keyword: exchange rate).

### **FedEx Rate Sheet FAQ**

# Q12: For what time period can I download my account based rates in FedEx Rate Sheet tool?

You can download rates at any time. You can download rates as much as 12 months in the past and as much as 45 days in the future. To download 2023 rates, you needs to select an effective date of 02/01/2023 or later.

#### Q13: When my rate download fails, what can I do?

It may be a temporary glitch. For immediate service, you can also reach out to your Sales Representative or Customer Service to provide them with the rates.

# Q14: How many users can be registered under one shipping account?

There is no limit on the no of users that can be registered under one account.

# Q15: How many users can be granted admin access for rate visibility?

Only 1 user can be granted admin access for rate visibility, but the admin could invite multiple users to view rates as "individual user role"

No limit on number of users invited by the rate administrator (note that all users invited by rate admin will automatically have access to FedEx Rate Sheet Tool)

#### Q16: Is zoning included in the FedEx Rate Sheets?

When you select services for the rate sheet download, you can tick a box to attach a zone chart to the rate sheet.
