REGULATORY CONDITIONS

1. This undertaking must be completed by the Shipper who must be fully aware of the Nature of Goods contained in the cargo consignment.
2. It is the responsibility of the Freight Forwarder and Cargo Agent;
 - a) To ensure that this undertaking is completed by the Shipper for every UAE originating cargo consignment.
 - b) To retain a hard or electronic copy of the completed undertaking in file for 12 months as a minimum, and make it accessible/available, as and when requested by GCAA.
 - c) To retain a copy of the undertaking during tendering the cargo consignment for acceptance in accordance with Subsection 3.11.1 of CAR Part VI .
