

Streamline your controlled export shipments

Expedite your clearance process for items controlled by the U.S. International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) and reduce the risk of customs delays with the FedEx International Controlled Export (FICE) service option.



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What is FICE?

FedEx® International Controlled Export (FICE) provides pickup, transportation, and import/export customs clearance of controlled exports from the United States and Puerto Rico to foreign locations that accept automated FedEx labels.

This service option is only available with FedEx International Priority® Express, FedEx International Priority®, FedEx International Priority® Freight, or FedEx International Priority DirectDistribution® services.

Please note: Paper air waybills cannot be used for FICE shipments.



FICE means extra assurance for smooth delivery of controlled goods

How does FICE help streamline my shipments?

The FICE service option gives you the convenience of customs-cleared, door-to-door delivery and the reliability of a time-definite commitment for controlled exports.¹

FICE can be used for export clearance and delivery of:

- Goods moving under a U.S. State Department (DSP) license, or under U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) export permits 36, 236, and 486.
- In-bond shipments moving under a transportation and exportation bond (CBP Form 7512) from a foreign trade zone or bonded warehouse.

¹A \$50 per-shipment handling charge applies to all FICE shipments.



Put FICE to work for you

The FICE service option typically delivers in 1–3 business days to more than 205 countries and territories.

FICE can be used for international controlled export shipments of any size, including many types of freight and multiple-piece shipments.

Please note: The FICE service option is only available to U.S. and Puerto Rico origin shipments and only through the following electronic shipping solutions: <u>FedEx Ship Manager® at fedex.com</u>, FedEx Ship Manager® Software, FedEx Ship Manager® Server, and <u>FedEx Web Services</u> or <u>FedEx APIs</u>. No other shipping systems can be used for this service.



Electronic Export Information filing option: enlist agent

FedEx files Electronic Export Information (EEI) as agent for customer:

(1) Customer

- Completes Shipper's Letter of Instruction or the FedEx Export AgentFile® form
- Emails it to FedEx

(2) FedEx

- Receives email or fax of Shipper's Letter of Instruction
- Submits it online via the Automated Export System (AES)
- Obtains Internal Transaction Number (ITN) from AES
- Provides ITN to customer

(3) Customer

- Creates shipping label on FedEx
 Ship Manager Software or FedEx
 Ship Manager at fedex.com
- Enters ITN into system

4 FedEx

- If there are no CBP holds, releases the shipment for export
- Verifies ITN is present on the label
- Closes open bonds with CBP



Electronic Export Information filing option: self-file

Customer self-files EEI:

1 Customer

- Files via the AES
- Receives ITN from AES
- Creates shipping label on FedEx Ship Manager
 Software or FedEx Ship Manager at fedex.com
- Enters ITN into system


(2) FedEx

- If there are no CBP holds, releases the shipment for export
- Verifies ITN is present on the label for DSP license shipments
- Closes open bonds with CBP




- 4 Select FedEx international controlled export under Service options.
- Select type of control and enter required fields for FICE type selected.
 - DEA: Permit No and Expiration Date
 - DSP: State Department License No and Expiration
 Date
 - T&E from a Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ): Bond Entry No. and FTZ Code
- 6 Read the FICE terms and conditions and select I have read, understood and agree to be bound by the FICE terms and conditions.







- 7 Select I have already filed or will file using AES.
- 8 Select the AES citation type, enter the AES citation number, then select the harmonized destination control statement type.

9 If asked, review your email confirmation and select "Continue" if correct.

- Your label should be marked CES for Controlled Export Service and have the X5 MEVA routing.
- Print the label and place it on your package in a resealable international pouch (available from FedEx).
- Place copies of any other shipping documents (EEI, Commercial Invoice, Certificate of Origin, for example) in the pouch.

What is International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR)?

We provide International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) shipment handling processes that align with ITAR regulations allowing shippers to export items covered by a U.S. State Department license and other shipments requiring additional documentation processing or governmental "sign-off" prior to export.

This service option is only available with FedEx International Priority® Express, FedEx International Priority®, or FedEx International Priority® Freight services.

Please note: Paper air waybills cannot be used for ITAR shipments.


ITAR-controlled commodities cannot enter or transit through countries or territories designated by the U.S. State Department as proscribed countries.

Our handling processes ensure sensitive shipments do not route through ITAR-prohibited countries or territories.




Step-by-step: shipping ITAR exempt via FedEx Ship Manager at fedex.com



- 4 Select ITAR (exempt) under Service options. The user selections may appear differently in your shipping solution based on if you are shipping from the U.S. or outside the U.S.
- 5 Enter exemption number. If the exemption number is not applicable, enter "000000".



Steps for shipping FICE via legacy Ship Manager











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
