Behind-the-counter prep

Personalize your advanced tracking dashboard⁵ so you can track up to 20,000 active packages.

Keep copies of manual airbills in case there's a discrepancy or issue.

Record tracking numbers, ship dates, and services used for all drop off packages. This is the information you'll need if there's a dispute. Please note that it's your responsibility to maintain this list.

Post the 2024 holiday shipping deadlines where your team can easily reference them.

Bookmark the holiday shipping page⁷ for information about new visibility tools, FAQs, and more.

Follow the package acceptance guidelines and record the necessary information.

- 1. Verify the customer's identity with their government-issued photo ID.
- 2. Record the name and address on the ID for each package to be consolidated.
