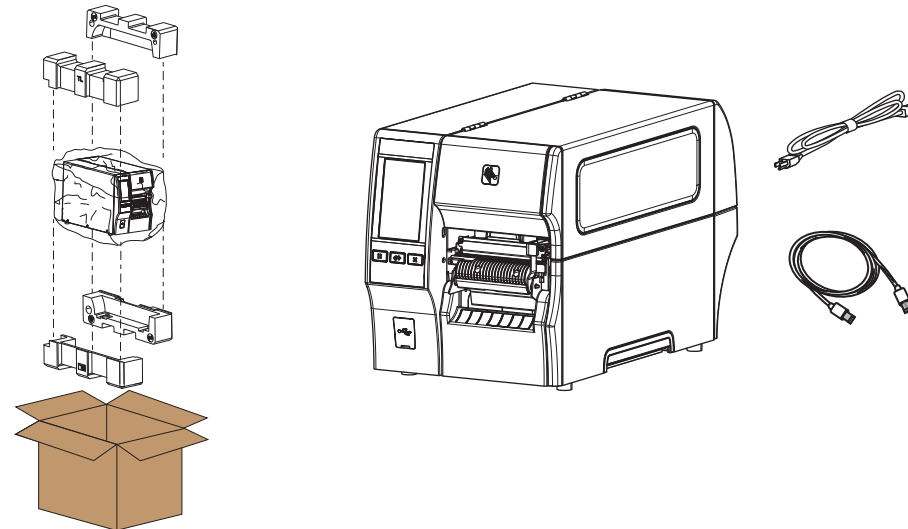

1 - Install the Printer Driver

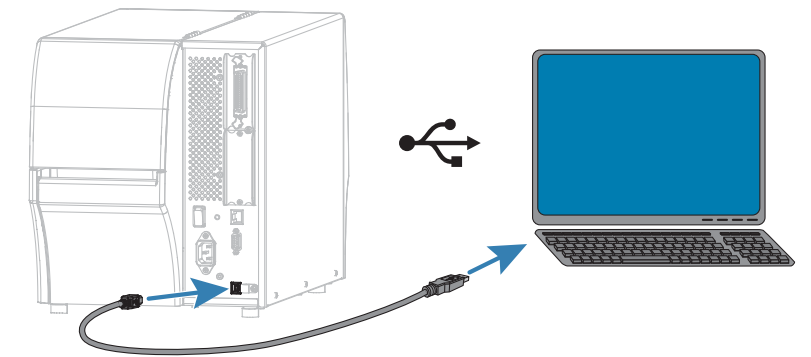

2 - Remove the Printer from the Box

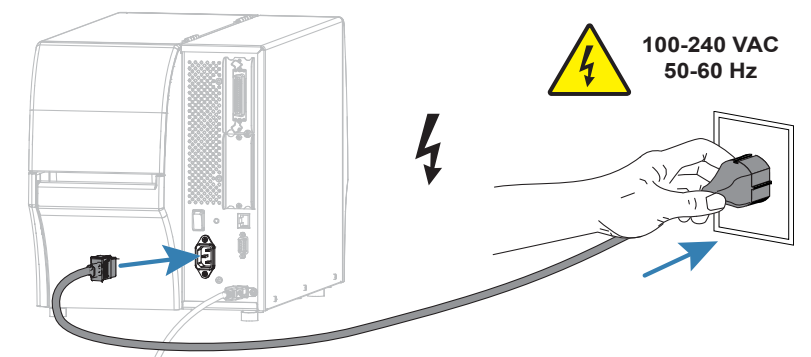

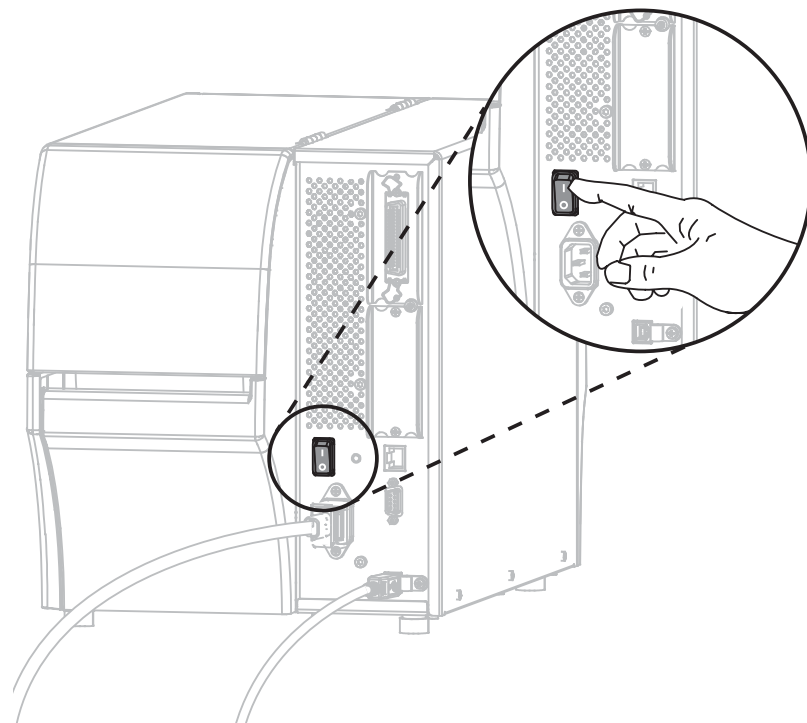
3 - Connect the USB Cord



4 - Plug In the Printer

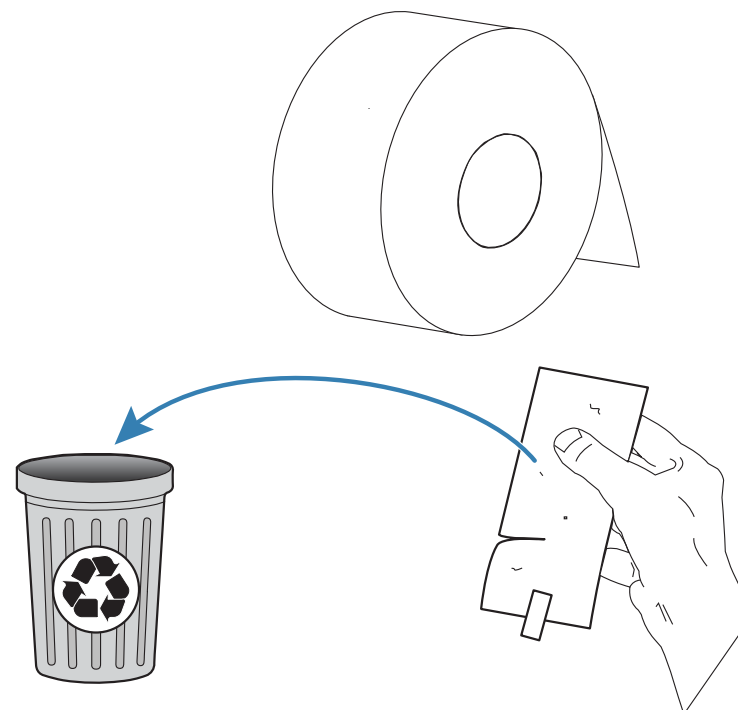


5 - Turn on the Printer



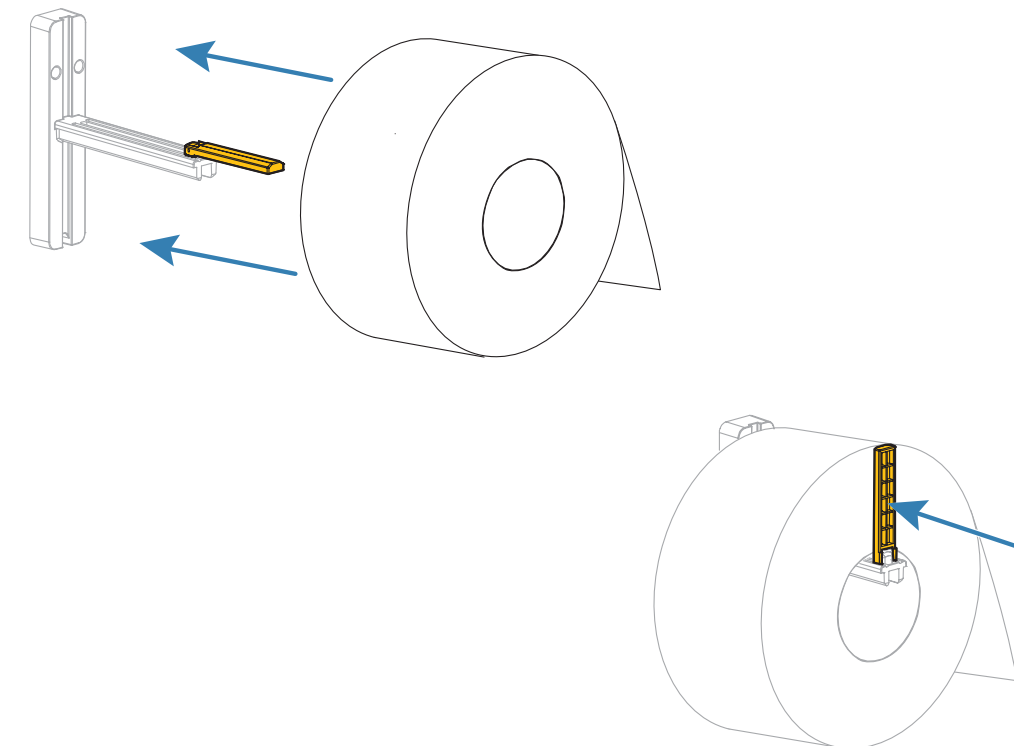
Connect the USB cord to the Microsoft Windows-based computer and the printer. Turn on the printer power.

6 - Recycle Damaged Labels



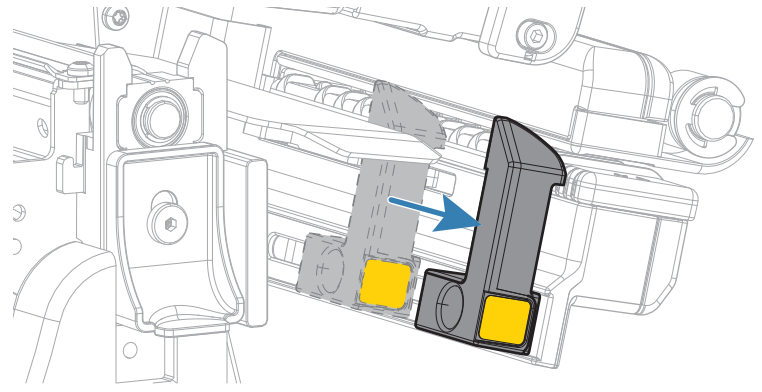
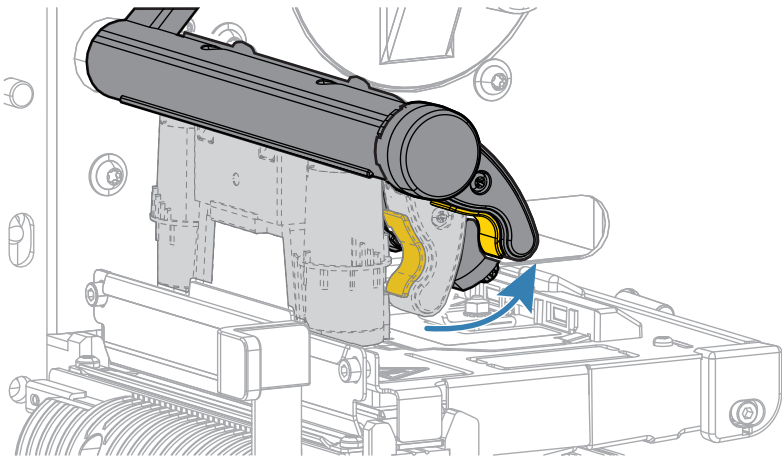
If necessary, remove and recycle any dirty or torn labels.

7 - Insert Media in the Printer

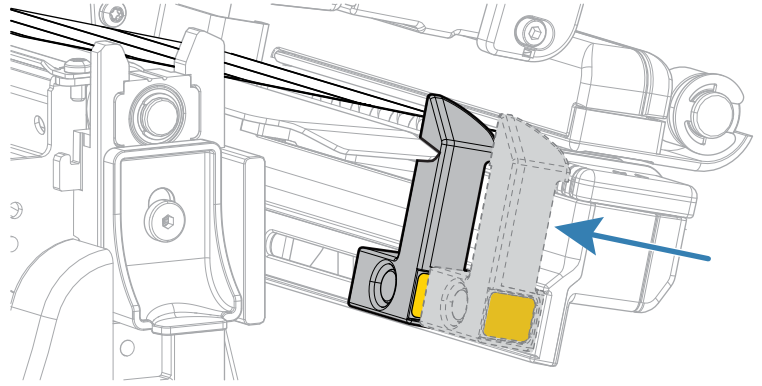
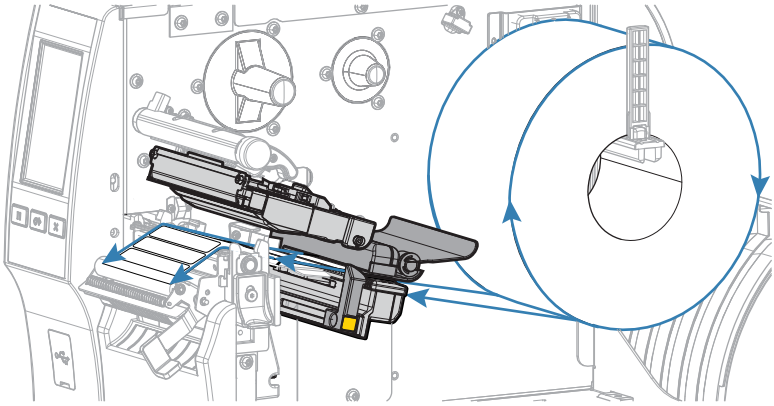


Fold down the media guide, and hang the roll of media on the media hanger. Fold up the media guide and slide it in until it almost touches the edge of the media.

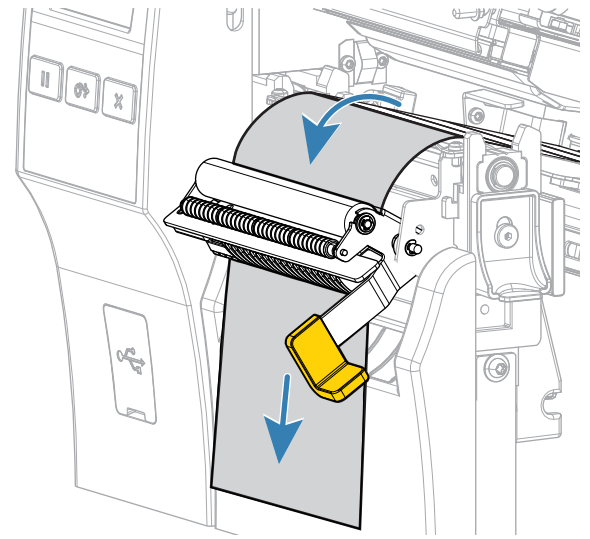
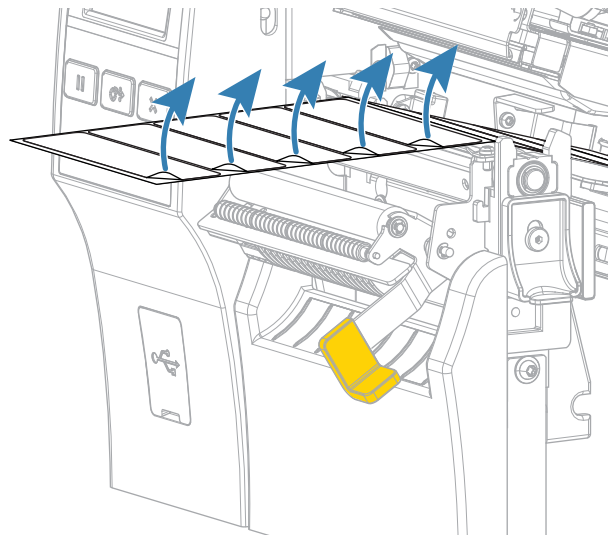
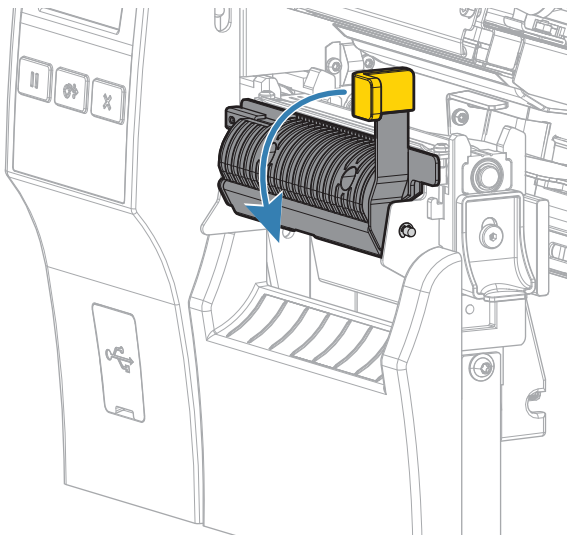
8 - Load Media



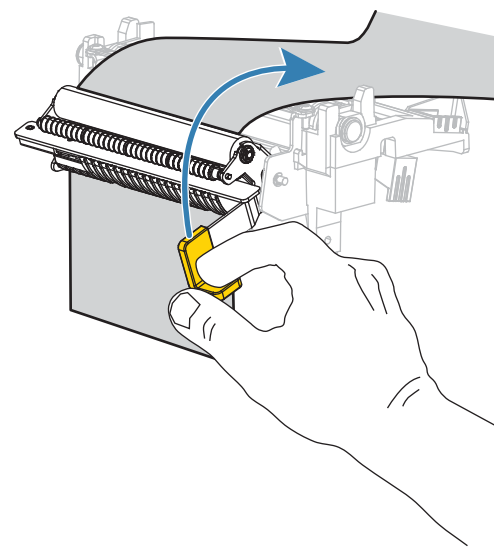
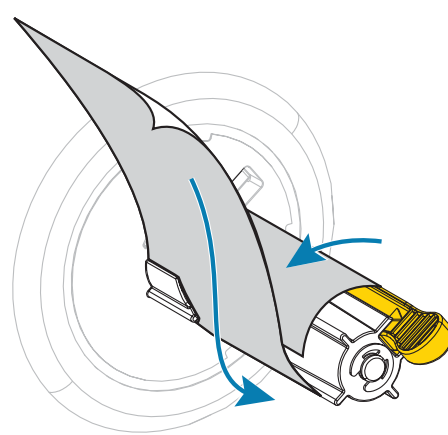
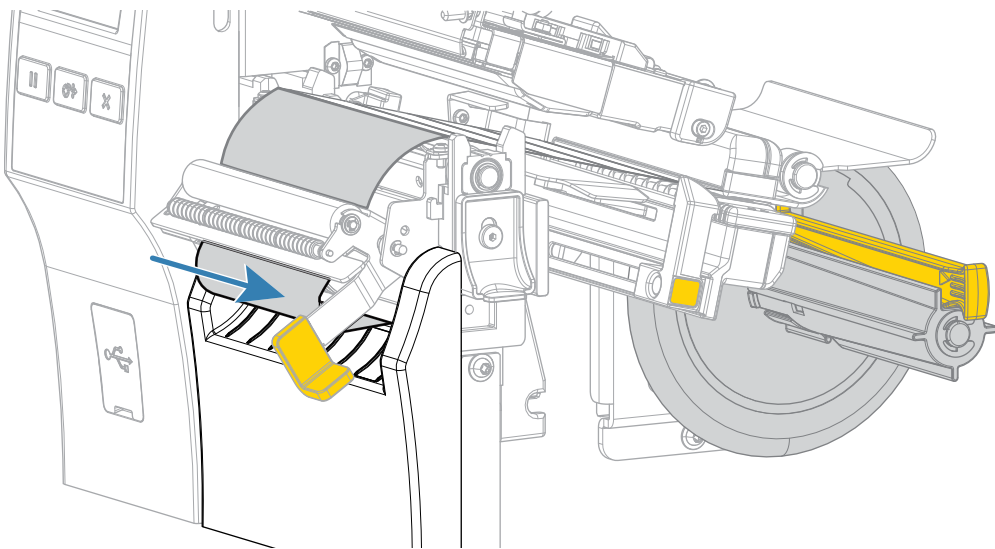
Open the printhead assembly and move the media guide out.



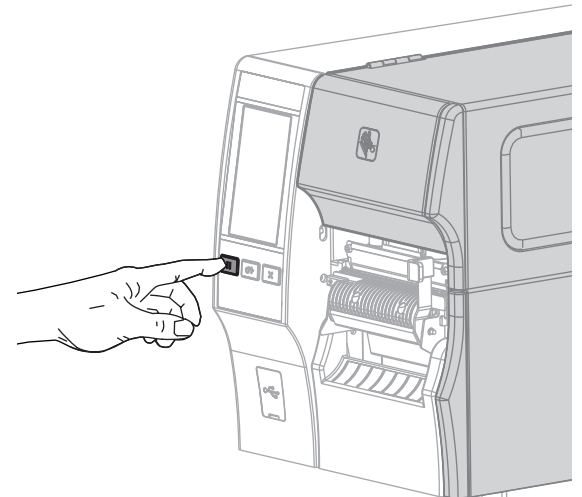
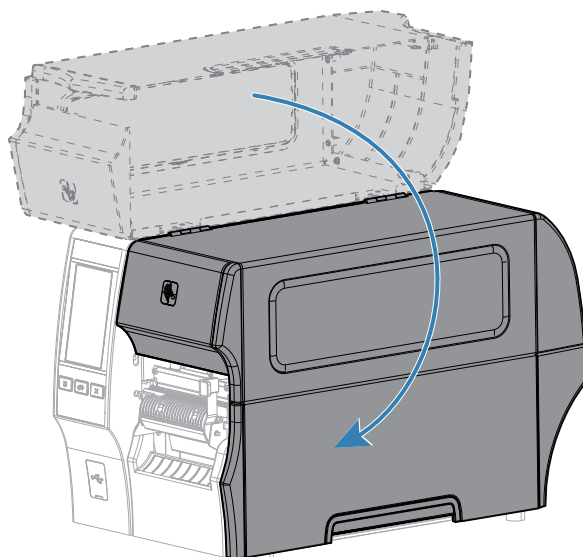
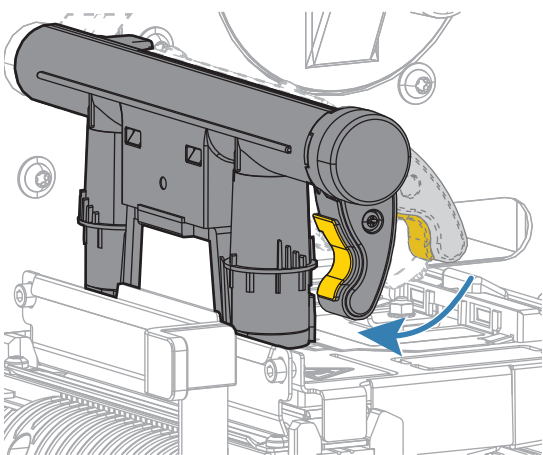
Feed the media as shown. Slide in the media guide until it almost touches the edge of the media



To use the peel-off feature, open the peel mechanism, remove some labels from the liner, and then load the liner through the peel mechanism.



To wind used liner, feed the liner through the slot under the peel mechanism and wrap around the liner take-up spindle. Close the peel mechanism when complete.



Close the printhead and the media door, and then press PAUSE to enable printing..
